





Difficulty in correcting pupils' language mistakes	 Peer conferencing during the editing stage Change in teacher's mindset to focus on the process instead of product

Challenges in eBook Making

Challenge	Solutions
Pupils complete the books at different rates	 Early finishers will engage in peer conferencing, provide technical support to peers, read and comment on books that are already published Pupils will complete books at home before 'Book Launch Day'


