## Objective

Let's Talk! helps students to engage in productive academic discussions by practising talk moves through playing a card game. Students can learn how to practise active listening, clarify and build on one another's ideas, and support or challenge other students. As they play, they collaborate in developing a deeper understanding of the discussion topic.



## **How to Play**

### **Preparation by Teacher**

- Craft 3 topic questions for discussion. The questions should be open-ended and allow multiple possible answers.
- Form groups of 4 to 5 players.
- Put the Mr Start cards into a separate pile.
- Give every player one of each type of card, excluding *Mr Start*. Each player will have a set of 6 cards at the beginning of the game.
- Shuffle the remaining cards and set them aside as the deck of extra cards.

#### Playing the Game

- 1. Select a player to receive a *Mr Start*. This player starts the discussion. Play then proceeds clockwise.
- 2. Each player chooses one of the sentence starters on his or her card and uses it to give a full statement to build on the response of the previous player.
- 3. If a player cannot continue the discussion, he or she can play Ms Wild or miss a turn and draw a card from the deck of extra cards.
- 4. When Mr Summarise is played, the player needs to summarise the discussion so far. The game then moves on to a new topic of discussion.
- 5. The game ends when any player plays his or her last card during their turn, or there are no more topics. The last card must be Mr Summarise.

#### Wild Cards

• A player can use Ms Wild at any time in the game when he or she cannot use other cards to contribute to the discussion. Players cannot use Ms Wild at the start or at the end of the game.




